The Condition of the above obligation is such, That, whereas, the above bounden

James Crabtree was, on the 4 day of June 1937
convicted in the County, of the offense Assault & Battery

and by the judgment of said Court sentenced to fine of \$5.00 & costs

And, whereas, the said James Crabtree
has this day prayed an appeal from said judgment to the Circuit Court of said County:

Now, if the said James Crabtree shall appear at the next term of the Circuit Court, and from term to term thereafter until discharged, and abide by and perform whatever sentence may be adjudged in said Court against him, then the above obligation to be void; otherwise to remain in full force and effect.
