are held and firmly bound unto the State of Alabama, in the sum of Two Hundred Dollars for the payment of which, well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors, and administrators, jointly and severally, firmly by these presents.

Witness our hands and seals, this the July day of 1923,

The Condition of the above Obligation is such, That, whereas, the above bounden

W.C. Bowen was, on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of July 1923, convicted in the County, of the offense possession of Whisky

and by the judgment of said Court sentenced to pay a fine of July \$50

And, whereas, the said W.C. Bowen

has this day prayed an appeal from said judgment to the Circuit Court of said County:

Now, if the said W.C. Bowen shall appear at the next term of the Circuit Court, and from term to term thereafter until discharged, and abide by and perform whatever sentence may be adjudged in said Court against him, then the above obligation to be void; otherwise to remain in full force and effect.
