TO THE HONORABLE F. W. HARE, JUDGE OF THE CIRCUIT COURT, BALDWIN COUNTY, ALABAMA, IN CHANCERY SITTING:

PART ONE

Your Complainant respectfully shows to the Court that she is over the age of twenty-one years and a bona fide resident of Bald-win County, Alabama, and that the Respondent is also over the age of twenty-one years and a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama.

PART TWO

- 1. Your Complainant further alleges and shows to the Court that she was lawfully married to the Respondent in Pensacola, Florida, on the 21st day of August, 1951, and ever since said marriage has conducted herself towards Respondent as a faithful and obedient wife.
- 2. That notwithstanding his marital duties and responsibilities, the Complainant has ever since said marriage been guilty of extreme cruelty towards your Complainant; he has many times abused and threatened her with physical violence and on numerous occasions has been guilty of physically assulting your Complainant and on Christmas day, 1942, he slapped and struck your Complainant and at that time she separated from him and they have not lived together since.
- 3. That the cruel and abusive treatment of the Respondent has affected the health of your Complainant and she is unable to live with the Respondent longer as his wife and desires a divorce from him.

PRAYER FOR PROCESS

WHEREFORE, your Complainant prays that your Honor will grant to her the writ of summons of the State of Alabama, commanding the Respondent to appear and answer, demur or plead to, this Bill of Complaint within the time allowed by law and abide such order and decree as may be entered herein and your Complainant will ever pray & c.

PRAYER FOR RELIEF

Your Complainant further prays that upon the final hearing of this cause your Honor will grant to her a decree of absolute divorce from the Respondent and that she may have such other and further relief in the premises as may be just and equitable.

TESTIMONY OF ALMA CALLAWAY

My name is Alma Callaway and I am the Complainant in this action for divorce.

I was married to the Respondent in Pensacola, Florida, on August 21, 1931, and we have made our home in Baldwin County ever since that time.

We never had any children.

For several years now the Respondent has been extremely cruel and abusive to me. He would find fault with everything I did and fly into a rage on the slightest provocation and, when angry, would threaten to beat me and kick me out of the house and on several occasions, he has actually assaulted me. The last time being last Christmas day, at which time he got angry and slapped me.

This constant bickering and his threats to hurt me were even worse than the actual assaults and had the effect of making me very nervous and ill and I find it impossible to live with him any longer and have not lived with him since last Christmas and desire a divorce on account of his cruel treatment of me.

TESTIMONY OF OTHA NALL.

My name is Otha Nall, I live in Foley, Alabama, and I have been well and personally acquainted with John Callaway and his wife Alma for many years. She and I have been close friends and they have been much in my home and I in theirs and have had many opportunities to observe their life together.

In recent years he seems to have become tired of her and has refused to go out with her or take her with him, has been fault-finding and hard to get along with and apt to fly into a rage with her over the most trivial matters. I have never seen him use actual physical violence to her, although I have heard he did, but I have seen and heard him threaten her, order her out of the house and for some time now she has lived in fear that he would injure her and this has affected her health and her nervous condition, she has lost weight and is ill and miserable all because of his treatment of her.

It is too bad they cannot live together happily but he has been so cruel and abusive that she could stand it no longer and I am sure they will both be better off separated.
