TO THE HONORABLE F. W. HARE, JUDGE OF THE CIRCUIT COURT OF BALDWIN COUNTY, ALABAMA: SITTING IN EQUITY

Comes GRACE C. POTTER and by this, her Bill of Complaint, presented against JOHN FRANK POTTER, respectfully shows:

FIRST: That she and the defendant above named are both over the age of twenty-one years, and are now and have been for more than five years next prior to the filing of this bill benafide residents of the County of Baldwin, in which County they have lived together as husband and wife since their marriage on June 24, 1939.

SECOND: Complainant further shows that within the last twelve months the defendant has committed actual violence on her person, attended with danger to her life and health and has on a number of occasions struck and otherwise maltreated her; the last occasion being on Sunday, February twenty-eighth last when he choked and beat her, severly blacking both of her eyes and otherwise maltreating her on this occasion, the fifth of a like nature. Complainant left her said husband and has since lived separate and apart from him and is unwilling to return fearing further and more serious injury.

THIRD: The parties of this case are the parents of a daughter, FRANCES EVELYN, born on January 7, 1942.

FOURTH: The defendant is an able-bodied man actively employed at a good rate of wages in a shippard in Mobile.

THE PREMISES CONSIDERED, complainant prays that the said

JOHN FRANK POTTER be made party defendant to this bill, and by ap
propriate process be required to answer same within the time prescribed

by law.

Complainant further prays that an order of reference be made requiring the Register of the Court to ascertain and report a suitable amount to be allowed complainant as alimony pendente lite, for her support and that of her infant child and for a suitable amount to be allowed her as permanent alimony and included in this decree of divorce hereinafter prayed.

Complainant further prays that upon the hearing of this cause a decree be rendered forever divorcing her from the said JOHN FRANK POTTER, granting her the right to marry again should she so desire, a reasonable sum for the support of herself and child, and for counsel fees incurred by her in this cause, the sole custody of the said child, and other, further or different relief as to equity may seem meet.
