Your complainant, Georgia Ruby Gardner, respectfully represents and shows unto your Honor:-

- 1. That complainant is over the age of twenty-one years and is a resident of said State and County, and has been a bona fide resident of said State for more than one year next preceding the filing of this Bill of Complaint; that Earl Gardner is over the age of twenty-one years and is not a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama, and whose place of residence is unknown to your complainant.
- 2. That your complainant and respondent were lawfully married on or about, to-wit, April 28, 1947.
- 3. Your complainant avers and charges that the said respondent did assault, beat, hit and strike complainant; that said respondent has committed actual violence on her person attended with danger to her life or health; complainant avers and charges that respondent has made numerous threats of doing her physical harm and from his manner and conduct toward her, she is reasonably convinced that he will commit an actual violence upon her person, attended with danger to her life or health.
- 4. Complainant shows that there was born unto your complainant and respondent of this marriage one child, Joseph Earl Gardner, age two and one-half years, which said child is in the custody and control of your complainant, and of which said child complainant desires custody and control.

PRAYER FOR PROCESS AND RELIEF

THE PREMISES CONSIDERED: Your complainants prays that Earl Gardner be made a party defendant to this cause by the usual process of this Honorable Court requiring him to plead, answer or demur within the time and under the penalties prescribed by the rule

of this Court and the statutes in such cases made and provided; that service be had upon the said respondent by publication in compliance with Equity Rule 6; that upon a final hearing of this cause that your complainant be granted a divorce from said respondent, and that she be granted custody of Joseph Earl Gardner. Should your complainant be mistaken in the relief prayed for, that there be granted to her such other, different and general relief to which she may be entitled and as in duty bound she will ever pray
