are held and firmly bound unto the State of Alabama in the sum of Three Hundred & 00/100 Dollars, for the payment of which, well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors, and administrators, jointly and severally, firmly by these presents.

Witness our hands and seals, this the _____ day of _____, 19____.

THE CONDITION OF THE ABOVE OBLIGATION IS SUCH, That, whereas, the above bounden

Carlton Weeks was, on the 22nd day of Nov

1938, convicted in the County Court of said County, of the offense of Disseing, or ralling ducks with a boat and firing a gun into said ducks,

and by the judgment of said Court sentenced to pay a fine of \$25⁰⁰ and court cost of \$5⁷⁵

And, whereas, the said Carlton Weeks has this day prayed an appeal from said judgment to the Circuit Court of said County.

Now, if the said Carlton Weeks shall appear at the next term of the Circuit Court, and from term to term thereafter until discharged, and abide by and perform whatever sentence may be adjudged in said Court against him, then the above obligation to be void; otherwise to remain in full force and effect; and each of us waive our exemptions as to personal property.
