THE CONDITION OF THE ABOVE OBLIGATION IS SUCH, That, whereas, the above bounden

Standley Weeks was, on the 22nd day of Nov 1938, convicted in the County Court of said County, of the offense of Driving, or pulling
ducks with a boat and firing a gun into
said ducks

and by the judgment of said Court sentenced to pay a fine of \$25.00 and
Court Cost of \$5.75

And, whereas, the said Standley Weeks has this day prayed an appeal from said judgment to the Circuit Court of said County.

Now, if the said Standley Weeks shall appear at the next term of the Circuit Court, and from term to term thereafter until discharged, and abide by and perform whatever sentence may be adjudged in said Court against him, then the above obligation to be void; otherwise to remain in full force and effect; and each of us waive our exemptions as to personal property.
