Assault and Battery

and by the judgment of said Court sentenced to

Ten Dollar Fine & Cost of Court

And, whereas, the said Herman Lowery has this day prayed an appeal from said judgment to the Circuit Court of said County.

Now, if the said Herman Lowery shall appear at the next term of the Circuit Court, and from term to term thereafter until discharged, and abide by and perform whatever sentence may be adjudged in said Court against him, then the above obligation to be void; otherwise to remain in full force and effect; and each of us waive our exemptions as to personal property.
