The Grand Jury of said County further charge that before the finding of this indictment, Otto Kaemmerer, alias Otto Kaemmer, whose name to the Grand Jury is otherwise unknown, did possess, keep, own, set up, operate or conduct, or permit to be set up, operated or conducted, a pin ball machine, which was a machine, mechanical device, contrivance, appliance or invention intended for the purpose of winning money by chance or hazard, contrary to law;

The Grand Jury of said County further charge that before the finding of this indictment, Otto Kaemmerer, alias Otto Kaemmer, whose name to the Grand Jury is otherwise unknown, did possess, keep, own, set up, operate or conduct, or permit to be set up, operated or conducted, a pin ball machine, which was a gambling device as defined by the laws of the State of Alabama;
