The Respondent and I have one child, 'ames Kenneth McDonald, who was born on September 8, 1948, The child has since the Respondent and I separated, been with my mother, Cora Lee Payne, and she has cared and provided for him. My mother, Cora Lee Payne, is the suitable, fit and proper person to have the care, custody and control of the minor child and the Respondent and I have agreed and entered into An written agreement, a copy of which is secured herewith, that my mother, Cora Lee Payne, shall have the custody, care and control of the minor child.

Cora Lee Payne, a witness for the Complainant, being first duly sworn deposes and says:

My name is Cora Lee Payne. I am the mother of Estelle McDonald and the grandmother of the minor child, James Kenneth McDonald.

The Complainant and the Respondent have lived near me practically all the time since they were married. I know from my own personal knowledge that conditions are such that the Complainant and the Respondent cannot live together as husband and wife and deem it highly advisable that they be granted a divorce.
