

My name is Charley Davidson. I am a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama, and over the age of twenty one years.

The Respondent, Ella Giles Davidson, and I were married in Pensacola, Florida, in November, 1935, and lived together as husband and wife until in March, 1936.

In March, 1936, and Respondent left me, and has remained away continuously since that time. I have repeatedly asked her to return to me, and have done nothing to make her remain away. She has consistently refused to return to my home.

She left me once prior to March, 1936, and returned to stay only a short time, when she left me and has remained away ever since.

Charley Mims, a witness for Complainant, being duly sworn, deposes and says: My name is Charley Mims. I am a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama, and am over the age of twenty one years.

I have been living near the Complainant in Summerville for a number of years, and know of my own knowledge that the Respondent abandoned him, some time in 1936, and has not at any time returned to his home since that time. The Complainant has done nothing to make her remain away during that time, but she has made it plain that she had no intention of returning to his home, and living with him as his wife.
