That there was born to the defendant and complainant three children, Jesse Leon Quinley, age 10, Buford Burns Quinley, age 6 and Cercy Glean Quinley, age 3; that Jesse Lee Quinley is the suitable and proper person to have care and custody of Jesse Lee Quinley, age 10 and Buford Burns Quinley, age 6, and can properly care for them at his parents home; that the complainant is the suitable and proper person to have the care and custody of Cercy Glean Quinley, age 3, and has a proper home in which to care for such child.

WHEREFORE your complainant prays that this Honorable Court will take the jurisdiction of the cause made by this bill of complaint and make the said Jesse Lee Quinley, party defendant hereto and by appropriate process require him to plead, answer or demur to the same within the time and under the pains and penalties prescribed by law and the practice of this Honorable Court.

Complainant further prays that upon the final hearing of this cause this Honorable Court will make and enter a decree forever dissolving the bonds of matrimony existing between the complainant and the said defendant; and that the court further order, judge and decree that the complainant, Mary Elizabeth Quinley, shall have the care and custody of the said Cercy Glean Quinley and that the defendant, Jesse Lee Quinley, shall have the care and custody of Lesse Leon Quinley and Buford Burns Quinley and that each of the said parties shall have the right to visit the children awarded to the custody of the other at suitable and proper times, and comprays for such other, further or different relief as in equity and good conscience she shall be entitled to receive in the premises.
