TO THE HONORABLE JUDGE OF THE CIRCUIT COURT
OF BALDWIN COUNTY, ALABAMA, SITTING IN EQUITY:

Comes now your petitioner, H. C. Devine, and
shows unto the Court as follows:

(1) That your petitioner, H. C. Devine, is a
resident and citizen of Baldwin County, State of Alabama; that
he is over the age of twenty-one years; and is the father of
James H. Devine, a minor over the age of eighteen years, said
minor having been born on the 7th day of *April*, 1917
said minor being a resident of said County of Baldwin, State of
Alabama, and residing with your petitioner.


(2) Your petitioner further shows that your
petitioner is not the guardian of said minor, and the said minor
has no guardian; and your petitioner further avers that the said
minor is thoroughly competent mentally and physically to enter into

That upon the hearing of this petition, this Honorable Court will decree that it is to the best interests of said minor to be relieved from all disabilities of non-age and will in said decree relieve said minor of all disabilities of non-age and invest said minor with the right to sue and be sued, contract, buy, sell, and convey real estate, and generally to do and perform all acts which said minor could lawfully do if twenty-one years of age. Petitioner prays for such other, further, different, and general relief as petitioner may be entitled to and as to the Court may seem meet and proper.
