COMES FEDERICO ROSSI and by this his Bill of Complaint, presented against ARGIA FAGIOLI ROSSI, respectfully shows:

First: That he is of the age of 52 years and that said Argia Fagioli Rossi is past the age of 21 years; that complainant has resided in Alabama for more than one year, at present living in Baldwin County; that respondent resides in the Town of Montebubbiano, Italy; that the parties to this suit were married to each other on September 8th 1913 at Ponzano di Fermo, Italy.

Second: That the respondent herein deserted complainant in August 1920 and has continued said desertion with total neglect of the marital duty on her part to the date hereof.

Third: That the respondent herein committed adultery with one "John Doe" subsequent to said desertion and that respondent became the mother of a child born more than one year subsequent to said desertion.

THE PREMISES CONSIDERED, Complainant prays that the said Argia Fagioli Rossi be made defendant to this bill and by appropriate process be required to answer the same within the time prescribed by law; That said process be in the form of service by registered mail upon The Alien Property Custodian at Washington, D. C. and, in addition thereto, that notice of the pendency of said action be further given by publishing same in accordance with the statute in such case made and provided in a newspaper published in said Baldwin County.

COMPLAINANT FURTHER PRAYS that, upon the hearing of this cause, that a decree be rendered forever divorcing said Federico Rossi from said Argia Fagioli Rossi, granting him the right to remarry should he so desire and such other, different and further relief as to Equity may seem meet.

I am 52 years of age. My wife, Argia Fagioli Rossi, who is 54 years of age, and I were married on September 8th 1913 at Ponzano di Fermo, Italy. In August of 1920, my wife left me and has ever since that date refused to live with me despite repeated attempts on my part to have her return to me. Prior to that date and during the year 1914, I had gone to Canada with the understanding that she would come there but she refused to do so. In 1918, I returned to Italy hoping to be able to persuade her to come with me but she refused. At that time, namely in 1918, I found that she had had a child the year prior thereto and, of course, that child was not mine. In spite of this, after due consideration, I was willing to forgive her and to have her return to me. I tried to get her to do this until 1920 at which time, I realized that she had no intention to do so. I have lived in Alabama for more than one year, at present living in Baldwin County, dock in Mobile. (At present I am employed at the Alabama Dry-dock in Mobile.)


