Comes CLARENCE BUCHANAN and by this, his Bill of Complaint, presented against MARGUERITE N. BUCHANAN, respectively shows:

THIRD: Complainant new charges the Defendant with adultery committed with said Clarence Beck in both Mobile and Baldwin Counties, but the exact times and places are unknown to Complainant.

THE PREMISES CONSIDERED, Complainant prays that Marguerite N. Buchanan be made party defendant to this bill and by appropriate process, required to answer same within the time prescribed by law.

Complainant further prays that uponuthethearing conthise cause, a decree be rendered forever divorcing him from the said Marguerite N. Buchanan, granting him the right to marry again should he so desire, and such other, further or different relief as to equity may seem meet.
