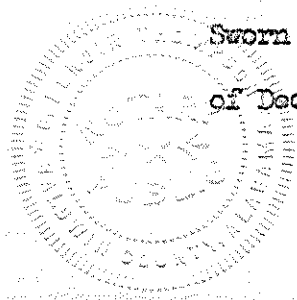

Ordered, adjudged and decreed by the court:

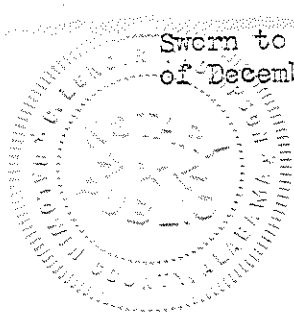
