It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that neither party to this suit shall again marry except to each other until sixty days after the rendition of this decree, and that if appeal is taken within sixty days, neither party shall again marry except to each other during the pendency of said appeal.

It is further ordered that the Complainant and Respondent be, and they are hereby permitted to again contract marriage upon the payment of the cost of this suit.

It is further ordered that ~~Complainant~~ Alice Louise Starkie the Complainant pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which execution may issue.

Cramer, Attorney, in Fairhope, Alabama, and having first sworn said Witnesses to speak the truth, the whole truth, and nothing but the truth, the said Alice Louise Starkie ~~(Mrs. J. S. Odom)~~ doth depose and say as follows:

I am 20 years of age and Calvin is 24. We were married on October 3rd 1947 in Bay Minette, Alabama, and have lived in Baldwin County together since that date until September 15th 1949 at which time we separated. I have continued to live in Baldwin County to the present date. We have a son, Calvin C. Starkie, Jr. who is now more than one year of age. At no time since we were married did Calvin ever support me and, later, the baby, to any degree that would be called living decently. For a long time prior to our separation, he has mistreated me. He has beaten me several times and has threatened to kill me. Usually, these beatings would result from my asking him for enough money to buy groceries or other necessities. I cannot go on subjecting myself to his treatment and, it appears quite apparent to me, now, that he has no desire to get together with me and to try to mend his ways. If I am granted a divorce, I would want the custody and care of my boy. I will be satisfied to permit Calvin to visit with the boy at reasonable times.

I am the Mother of Alice Louise Starkie. I know that she and Calvin have been having considerable trouble getting along together for a couple of years past. I know that he has never properly supported my daughter and their son. As to his treatment of her, I have not seen any of the occurrences but Alice has come to my home several times when it was apparent that she was very much upset and appeared afraid to go back to her own home. I gathered from her, at such times, that Calvin had been mistreating her physically.
