It is further ordered that ROBERT STALLWORTH the COMPLAINANT pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which execution may issue.

Now comes Annie Stallworth, the Respondent named in the above entitled cause, and for answer to the Bill of Complaint filed against her herein says:


