Ordered, Adjudged and Decreed by the Court that a copy of the petition for the removal of the disabilities of Gray Lambert, (Jr.) be served on the minor by mailing a copy thereof by registered mail, postage prepaid, the envelope containing the said copy of said petition for removal of the disabilities of the said Gray Lambert, (Jr.), shall be marked "For delivery only to the person to whom addressed", and the Register shall demand of the post office authority a return receipt; and that such return receipt when received shall be filed in the cause and entered upon the final record of the court, together with the certificate of the Register giving the date that the copy of the petition was mailed by him, and the date the return receipt was received by the Register.


