for and on account of Cruelty



It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that neither party to this suit shall again marry except to each other until sixty days after the rendition of this decree, and that if appeal is taken within sixty days, neither party shall again marry except to each other during the pendency of said appeal.

It is further ordered that Olga Faye McDaniel and Schuler McDaniel be, and ~~they are~~ hereby permitted to again contract marriage upon the payment of the cost of this suit.

It is further ordered that Schuler McDaniel the Respondent pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which execution may issue.

TO HONORABLE F. W. HARE, JUDGE OF THE CIRCUIT COURT OF BALDWIN COUNTY, ALABAMA,
IN EQUITY:

Now comes your Complainant, Olga Faye McDaniel, and humbly complaining against the Respondent, Schuler McDaniel, respectfully represents and shows unto your Honor and this Honorable Court as follows:

1.

That the Complainant and the Respondent are both over the age of twenty one years, and residents of Mobile County, Alabama;

2.

That your Complainant and the Respondent were married in Mobile, on October 30th, 1942, and lived together as husband and wife until May 18th, 1943.

3.

That on, to-wit, May 18th, 1943, and at various other times prior thereto, the Respondent threatened and abused the Complainant, and on several occasions threatened to do actual violence to her person which would necessarily endanger her life and health; that the conduct of the Respondent

was such as to give Complainant every reasonable apprehension to believe, and she did actually believe, that if she continued to live with him he would carry out his threats and do violence to her person which would necessarily endanger her life and health.

PRAYER FOR PROCESS.

Wherefore, the premises considered, your Complainant prays that your Honor will, by proper process, make the said SCHULER McDANIEL party Respondent to this Bill of Complaint, requiring him to plead, answer or demur to the same within the time and under the penalties prescribed by law and the practice of this Honorable Court.

Complainant further prays that upon a final hearing hereof, your Honor will give and grant unto her an absolute decree of divorce, forever barring the bonds of matrimony existing between her and the Respondent, and that your Honor will give and grant unto her such other, further, different and general relief as she may be in equity and good conscience entitled to receive, and as in duty bound she will ever pray.
