

The above named witnesses, appeared before me at the time and place hereinafter stated and upon examination by counsel for Complainant, after being sworn, testified as follows:

NELLIE DANA BOHANON

I am the Complainant in this cause and, like the Defendant, am over the age of twenty-one years. I was born and raised in Baldwin County, where I still live, but my husband was born in Monroe County and came to Baldwin about 1935, and lived here until August, 1946 when he left me and his family three months before the birth of my youngest child and went to Mobile where he is now living, presumably under an assumed name, as while he has been seen, no one knows him by name in that locality. We lived together as husband and wife from the date of our marriage in August, 1939 to August, 1946. In that time there were born to us five children, one of whom died and the other four still live with me at the home of my father, Edward Dana, below Point Clear. These children are: Sylvia Marie, aged ten years; Marvin Edward, aged eight years; Robert Harold, aged five years and Mary Jane, aged three years. Since my husband left me, I have not seen him nor has he done anything for me or for the children, though I understand that he is living in Mobile where he is employed. As stated, I have been utterly abandoned by him since August, 1946 and but for the support that I get from my father and the Welfare people, we would be destitute.

I am a resident of Point Clear, Alabama, where I have lived since my early childhood and live about a mile and a quarter from the residence of Mr. Edward Dana, the father of Mrs. Bohanon.
