It is further ordered that either party hereto be, and is hereby permitted to again contract marriage upon the payment of the cost of this suit.

It is further ordered that Kenneth Stewart Rollins, the Respondent, pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which execution may issue.

To the Honorable F. W. Hare, Judge of said Court, sitting in Equity:

Comes Your Complainant, Mary Jane Rollins, and respectfully exhibits this, her Bill of Complaint against Kenneth Stewart Rollins and shows unto Your Honor as follows:

First: Complainant and Respondent intermarried on October 17th 1938 at Columbus, Mississippi, and lived thereafter together as husband and wife in Fairhope, Alabama, until March 10th 1943 when, as a result of the acts complained of herein, the parties hereto separated.

Second: Complainant is past the age of 21 years and Respondent is 24 years of age and both parties are, at present, residents of Baldwin County, Alabama, and have been since said marriage.

Third: On March 10th 1943, and on several occasions prior thereto, Respondent conducted himself toward Complainant in such manner as to cause her to be apprehensive of violence attendant with danger to her life, limb and health; that he repeatedly threatened her with injury and attacked her so as to put her in fear of her life, health and limbs.

Prayer for process: Your Complainant prays Your Honor to grant her all appropriate and legal process and that same be directed to said Kenneth Stewart Rollins demanding him to personally appear before this Honorable Court within the time prescribed by law and to then and there answer fully and completely the several paragraphs of this Bill of Complaint and that he be required to abide and obey all orders and decrees of this Court which to Your Honor may seem meet and proper.

Prayer for Relief: Complainant further prays upon the hearing of this cause that a decree be rendered forever divorcing her from said Kenneth Stewart Rollins, granting her the right to remarry again should she so desire and such further and different relief as may be or appear proper in the premises.
