FINAL DECREE

This cause coming on to be heard on this date is submitted for final decree on the original Bill of Complaint, Answer of the Respondent and the testimony as noted by the Register, upon consideration of all of which the Court is of the opinion that the Complainant is entitled to the relief prayed for in her said Bill of Complaint; whereupon, it is, therefore, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court as follows:

1. The bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the Complainant, Essie Mae Chaudron, and the Respondent, William C. Chaudron, be and the same are hereby dissolved and the said Complainant is forever divorced from the said Respondent on the ground of abandonment.
2. The Complainant and Respondent be and they are each hereby permitted to contract marriage.
3. The said Complainant and the said Respondent shall not marry, except to each other, until sixty days after this date and if an appeal is taken in this cause within sixty days, they shall not marry, except to each other during the pendency of said appeal.
4. The costs of this cause are hereby taxed against the Complainant, for which execution may issue.



Chaudron, is over twenty-one years of age and a resident of Mobile County, Alabama, his residence and post office address being 1 North Scott Street, Mobile, Alabama.


2. Your Oratrix and the said William C. Chaudron were lawfully married by the Judge of Probate of Monroe County, Alabama on June 11, 1926, and lived together as man and wife until during the month of March, 1941, at which time the Respondent voluntarily abandoned her without fault on her part and they have not lived together since the said date.

PRAYER FOR PROCESS

Your Oratrix prays that the Court will take jurisdiction of the cause made by this Bill of Complaint, that due notice thereof be given the Respondent, William C. Chaudron in the form and manner prescribed by law requiring him to plead to, answer or demur to the Bill of Complaint within the time and under the pains and penalties prescribed by law and the practice of this honorable court.

PRAYER FOR RELIEF

THE PREMISES CONSIDERED, your Oratrix prays that upon a final hearing of this cause the Court will make and enter a proper order or decree dissolving the bonds of matrimony now existing between your Oratrix and the said Respondent. Your Oratrix further prays for such other, further and general relief as she may be equitably entitled to the premises considered.
