Chaney Douglas:

Alvin showed Chaney Douglas down by stove. Fine home with groceries was 3:30 P.M. or 4 P.M. Home long enough for Chaney to bail ~~the~~ <sup>for</sup> breakfast for lunch of Oliver & Alvin who were going fishing.

About this time Alvin & Susie Rice came up and had both been drinking. I drank 2 glasses of wine and Alvin and Oliver drank 2 or 3 glasses of wine.

Alvin lived with Oliver and myself. He cussed me that afternoon when we met up to Mr. Penner to get checks. Alvin gave Oliver \$20.00 to get \$9.00 out for groceries. As we drove off Alvin called to Oliver to get his change as he might need it. Alvin then took the \$20.00 bill and changed it giving Oliver \$9.00. We went on home and Alvin & Susie Rice came a short time after.

Oliver asked Alvin if he was going fishing and he replied yes and



went into his room.  
Oliver picked up the fishing tackle  
and shot gun and Alvin came out  
of his room cussing and advanced  
toward Oliver striking at him with  
the knife he had in his hand.  
I saw the knife in Alvin's hand  
then turned toward the table when  
Oliver shot Alvin.

Oliver then went out side and  
said "Lord I don't hate my brother".  
June Rice was in the house at  
time of shooting by the radio.  
Fishing tackle ~~was in~~ kept on  
back Porch.
