within sixty days, neither party shall again marry except to each other during the pendency of said
appeal.

be, and ~~are~~ hereby permitted to again contract marriage upon the payment of the cost of
this suit.

It is further ordered that Annie Mills Sellers,
the Complainant pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which execution may issue.

TO THE

HONORABLE F. W. HARE, JUDGE OF THE CIRCUIT COURT

Comes ANNIE MILL SELLERS, and by this her Bill of Complaint presented against MICHAEL SELLERS, respectfully shows:

FIRST: That Complainant and Defendant are both over the age of twenty-one years and life long and bona fide residents of Baldwin County, Alabama, although Complainant is now temporarily in the State of Florida.

SECOND: That the parties hereto were married in Fairhope, Alabama in March, 1942 and lived together as husband and wife up to June 1st, when they parted, Complainant going to Florida.

THIRD: That since Complainant left Baldwin County, the Defendant has been guilty of adultery, and is now living alone with another woman at Complainant's former home several miles outside of Fairhope, as Complainant is reliably informed and so charges.

THE PREMISES CONSIDERED, Complainant prays that MICHAEL SELLERS be made Defendant to this bill and by proper process be required to answer same within the time prescribed by law.

Complainant further prays that upon the hearing of this cause a decree be rendered forever divorcing her from the said MICHAEL SELLERS, granting her the right to marry again if she so desires; to resume her maiden name, and to have such other, further or different relief as to equity may seem meet.


