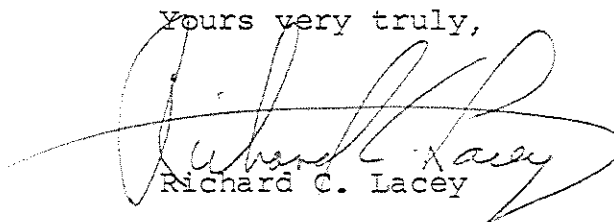

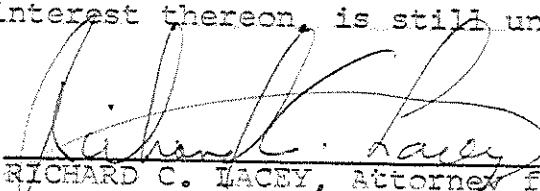
BILL OF COMPLAINT

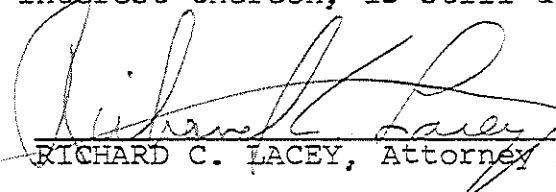
