

TO THE HONORABLE F. W. HARE, JUDGE OF THE CIRCUIT COURT OF BALDWIN COUNTY, ALABAMA, SITTING IN EQUITY:

Your Oratrix, Opal Garner, presents this Bill of Complaint against Wesley Garner and thereupon your Oratrix complains and shows unto the Court as follows:

- 1. Your Oratrix is a married woman over twenty years of age and a bona fide resident citizen of Baldwin County, Alabama, where she has resided for more than one year next preceding the filing of this Bill of Complaint and the Respondent, Wesley Garner, is over twenty-one years of age and a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama.
- 2. Your Oratrix and the said Wesley Garner were lawfully married at Bay Minette in Baldwin County, Alabama, on the 1st day of July, 1939 and lived together as man and wife until Easter Sunday, 1943 when they separated.

On Easter Sunday, 1943, immediately prior to the time your Oratrix separated from the said Respondent, he struck your Oratrix with his hand and threatened to kill her. Because of his said conduct, she was put in fear of being severely injured or done great bodily harm if she tried to continue to live with him. She separated from him immediately thereafter and they have not lived together since the said date.

PRAYER FOR PROCESS

Your Oratrix prays that the Court will take jurisdiction of the cause made by this Bill of Complaint and that due
notice thereof be given to the Respondent, Wesley Garner, in the
form and manner prescribed by law, requiring him to plead to, answer
or demur to the said Bill of Complaint within the time and under
the pains and penalties prescribed by law and the practice of this
Honorable Court.

- That the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing 7. between the Complainant and the Respondent be and the same are hereby dissolved and the Complainant is forever divorced from the Respondent on the ground of cruelty.
- That the Complainant and the Respondent be and 2. they are each hereby permitted to again contract marriage.
- 3. That the said parties shall not marry except to each other until sixty days after this date, and if an appeal is taken within sixty days, they shall not again marry, except to each other during the pendency of the said appeal.
- 4. That the costs of this cause be and they are hereby taxed against the Respondent, for which execution may issue.

My name is Opal Garner.

I am twenty years of age and a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama where I have resided all of my life. I was lawfully married to the Respondent, Wesley Garner, in Bay Minette, Alabama on July 1, 1939 and lived with him as his wife until Easter Sunday in this year when we separated. Shortly before we separated the said Wesley Garner abused and threatened me and struck me with his hand.
