Q. Mr. Aldridge, what is your occupation at this time?A. Trust officer of the Merchants National Bank ofMobile, Alabama.

Q. Is the Merchants National Bank of Mobile Executorof the last will and testament of Frank Manci, deceased?A. Yes sir.

Q. I will ask you if you handled this matter from the time the will was probated?

A. Yes sir.

Q. More than six months have expired since the will was admitted to Probate and record?

A. Yes sir.

Q. I will ask you whetheror not all claims against the Estate other than the Executor's Commission and Attorney's fees have been paid?

A. Yes sir.

Q. Have you filed an estate tax return?

A. Yes sir.

Q. I will ask you if you have paid the estate tax due as shown by the return?

A. Yes sir.

Q. Now those who take under the will of Mr. Frank Manci are set out in paragraph five of the petition for a partial settlement, and are as follows: Mary E. Manci, widow, Arthur Manci, Frank Manci, Jr., Orlando J. Manci, Julia M. Batchelder, Amelia Breitling, Antonina M. Edmonds, Carolyn M. Ray and Alvera M. Trione?

A. Yes sir.

Q. They are the ones that take under the will of Mr. Frank Manci, deceased?

Q. Now all of those with the exception of the widow, are children of Mr. Frank Manci, are they not?

Q. And all over 21 years of age and of sound mind?

A. Well we had the estate appraised and it ran about \$94,000

or \$95,000.00 according to the estate tax return; this included some \$11,000.00 in bonds, which we had to handle; they were not a part of the Probate Estate. It was necessary for us to act as distributing agent, notify the Government and distribute the checks and help them out so far as getting the bonds handled; and they - - there were eight parcels of land involved, which was scattered all around, which made up a large portion of the estate and while most of it passed directly under the will, it was still necessary to identify each parcel and determine the details concerning the different parcels of land, such as improvements made by different persons. In otherwords, some of his people made improvements. One house projected over on another lot, and this we had to assist the appraisers in showing them where it lay and the interest in those particular pieces of land. I made trip after trip over there myself with a tape, measuring and handling that. There was

an option under the terms of the will where one of the beneficiaries and a nephew could acquire two parcels of real estate by purchase, if they so desired within six months and it provided for the disposition of 720 acres of improved land, and there wasn't but 600 acres. I went back over 20 years of assessments trying to locate what had happened to the other land. The main complicating factor, and which involved the entire bank - the President and senior officers, was the question of a partnership. It was alleged that Mr. Frank Manci did have an interest in this partnership with two other partners - they contended that there was no interest there was no partnership involved - and all of the different heirs had different ideas about his interest from zero up to a substantial amount and we went through accountants and lawyers and with directors and interviewed the whole estate: we were trying to obtain some information about the partnership and finally I, after consideration by all of the bests minds available, we reached a settlement of this partnership and reached an agreement and sold the partnership interest to the substantial benefit of the estate; that involved bringing the matter to the Courts, so if any one, if they desired, could have an opportunty to object to it; they had all had odds, so to speak, on this thing, but it was worked out satisfactorily and what I thought was going to be a long drawn out law suit, turned out to be all right.

Q. All right, you realized approximately \$15,000.00 osn that? A. Yes sir - working up the facts that involved a complete audit of the three businesses - Manci Farms, Manci filling Station and Daphne Cleaners; we had to count the cattle and get it appraised; I went in the store and helped them take inventory of cigarettes, pool tables and equipment of the Daphne Cleaning Company, and it was a very laborious task and we got together and formed the basis on which we were able to do this thing; we don't want to ever come into this court asking

friviously for extra compensation; I discussed that with my senior officers abd we feel, in order to come out on the estate, we will be justified in asking for extra compenaation, and I have written to the heirs, pointing out in my letter that I was asking for this additional compensation. I would be glad to show you the letters to each of the heirs. I wanted them to know exactly what we were doing; it was unusual for us to do something like this and I wanted them to know the exact amount that I was asking and I told them that it was more than the amount that was ordinarily allowed and I called that particular provision to the attention of each one of the heirs in my letter.

Q. In that connection, have you had any complaint from any of them?

A. Not a one in the world; not the first one.

Q. What figure, Mr. Aldridge, do you think the Bank is entitled to, both statutory and compensation for extra ordinary services?

THE COURT: Separately?

Q. Yes, I'm going to separate them.. Is it a total of \$1852.66?

A. Yes.

Q. That is the combined extra-ordinary and regular statutory compensation or commissions?

TO THE HONORABLE HUBERT M. HALL, JUDGE OF THE CIRCUIT COURT OF BALDWIN COUNTY, ALABAMA, SITTING IN EQUITY:

Your Petitioner, The Merchants National Bank of Mobile, a National Banking Association, respectfully represents unto the court and your Honor as follows:

1. On, to-wit, August 17, 1953, the Last Will and Testament of Frank Manci, Deceased, was admitted to probate and record in and by the Probate Court of Baldwin County, Alabama, a copy of which Will is attached hereto, marked "Exhibit A" and by reference made a part hereof as though fully incorporated herein, on which said date Letters Testamentary were issued to Petitioner, as Executor of and under the said Will, which said Letters Testamentary are now in full force and effect.

2. After the said Will of the said decedent was admitted to probate and record in and by the Probate Court of Baldwin County, Alabama, it was necessary that the administration of this said estate be removed from the Probate Court of Baldwin County, Alabama, to this court because of the broader powers of this court, and because it is necessary that the broad powers of this court be invoked in properly administering the affairs of this said estate.

3. After being appointed Executor of this said estate, Petitioner determined that the decedent, Frank Manci, owned an interest in a joint venture or partnership with Arthur Manci, who is a son of the decedent, and Angelo F. Trione, who is a grandson of the said decedent. After securing some information about the said joint venture or partnership and its property, Petitioner, as said Executor, employed V. R. Pritchard and Company, Certified Public Accountants of the City of Mobile, Alabama, to make an examination of the records and businesses conducted under the trade names of Manci's Farms, Manci's Service Station and Daphne Cleaners, which are the joint ventures or partnerships in which the said decedent, Frank Manci, owned an interest, for the purpose of determining their financial position as of July 8, 1953, which was the date of the death of the said decedent, and for the purpose of determining what property and assets were included in and formed the capital of the said joint venture or ventures, or the said partnership or partnerships.

The Last Will and Testament of the said decedent pro-4. vides that Petitioner, as said Executor, would not be required to file any inventory or appraisal of the assets of the said estate. but it has been necessary for Petitioner, as said Executor, to have an appraisal made of all of the property of the said estate so that it can prepare and file a proper estate tax return for the said estate, and so that it could secure all possible information as to the estate's interest in the said joint ventures or in the said partnerships. During the month of October, 1953, Petitioner, as said Executor, secured the services of J. E. Gooden, who is a real estate broker and appraiser, residing at Fairhope, Alabama; Leslie C. Bambarger, a farmer, residing near Fairhope, Alabama, and near the property owned by the said ventures or partnerships; and D. S. Pennington, Sr., an auctioneer, appraiser and real estate broker. residing in Mobile, Alabama, who made a joint appraisal of all of the property and assets of this said estate, including the assets of the three above named firms, and filed their report with Petitioner, as said Executor, on October 15, 1953, in which they list ed the overall capital worth of the said businesses as of the date of the death of the decedent, Frank Manci, at the sum of \$46,696.36.

5. On, to-wit, the 21st day of September, 1953, Arthur Manci and Angelo F. Trione, the surviving joint adventurers, if the said firms described above were joint ventures, or the surviving partners of the said firms, if they were partnerships, made a written offer to Petitioner to purchase this estate's interest in the said business or businesses for the sum of \$15,000 cash, a copy of which offer is hereto attached, marked "Exhibit B" and by reference made a part hereof as though fully incorporated herein.

6. Petitioner, through its trust officers, has made a

diligent search for a written agreement between the decedent, Frank Manci, Arthur Manci and Angelo F. Trione, creating or forming the said ventures or partnerships, but has been unable to locate any such written agreement, and it, therefore, alleges, on information and belief, that there was no written agreement between the said parties under which the said businesses were created or conducted. The bank account of the said businesses was opened in the Merchants National Bank of Mobile in the name of Arthur Manci on, to-wit, March 31, 1937, and was carried as such until on, to-wit, March 9, 1953, when the said account or accounts were changed to Manci Farms, which designated Arthur Manci and Angelo F. Trione as the sole partners named therein.

On, to-wit, March 16, 1953, an account was opened in the Bank of Fairhope at Fairhope, Alabama, in the name of Daphne Cleaners, and on the said date another account was opened in the said bank in the name of Manci's Service Station, in both of which said accounts Arthur Manci and Angelo F. Trione were the only persons authorized to sign checks and withdraw funds from the said accounts.

Partnership tax returns were filed by Manci Farms for all of the tax years commencing January 1, 1941, and going through the year of December 31, 1952, all of which returns showed that Frank Manci received one-third of the profits from the said business or businesses during all of the said period of time.

7. After receiving the said offer, Petitioner has required one of its trust officers to visit or communicate with all of the members of the Manci family, who are all of the devisees and legatees named in the Last Will and Testament described above, and confer with them for the purpose of securing all possible information about the said businesses, about the interest which the said decedent, Frank Manci, had or may have therein, which conferences were had with the said members of the said Manci family by Garet V. Aldridge, one of Petitioner's trust officers. After the said conferences the entire matter was discussed at length with Petitioner's officers, its President and other officers, and with its trust committee, which is composed of members of its Board of

Directors; various conferences have been had about the said offer, about the interest of the said estate in the said business or businesses and the action which should be taken by Petitioner on the said offer of Arthur Manci and Angelo F. Trione, and after such conferences Petitioner recommends that the said offer of \$15,000 be accepted and that Petitioner, as said Executor, be authorized to sell and convey all of the said estate's interest in and to all of the three said businesses and the property constituting the assets thereof, including cattle and growing crops, to the said Arthur Manci and Angelo F. Trione, provided that the said purchasers are required to pay any and all claim or claims against the said businesses or any of them, including compensation to the said partners, and provided further that Petitioner, as said Executor. be indemnified by the said purchasers from all costs and damage because of claims being made against it as such Executor for claims, debts or obligations of the said businesses or any of them.

8. The Last Will and Testament of the said decedent, which is set out above, authorizes Petitioner to sell and convey property belonging to the said estate and to compromise, adjust and otherwise settle all claims in favor of or against the said estate, but because of the fiduciary relationship of the said Arthur Manci and Angelo F.
