Alabama; and that the petitioner pay the costs in this behalf incurred.





Your Petitioner, the undersigned, respectfully shows unto this Honorable Court the following.

1. That she is over the age of twenty-one years and is a bone fide resident citizen of Baldwin County, Alabama.

2. That she is the mother of Leroy Curtis Lehmann, a minor over the age of eighteen years; and that his father is dead; and that said minor has no legal guardian; and that said minor resides with the Petitioner in Baldwin County, Alabama.






