Headley</u>, from all of which it appears to the court that the allegations of the said petition are true and that the said Petitioner is entitled to the relief prayed for by him in the said petition, upon consideration of all of which it is, therefore, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the court as follows:

4. The costs of this proceeding are hereby taxed against Petitioner, for which execution may issue.

Your Petitioner, Donald N. Bryant, respectfully represents unto the court and your Honor as follows:

1. He is a minor over eighteen years of age, having been born on October 18, 1935, and became eighteen years of age on October 18, 1953.

2. He is a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama, and owns an interest in real property which is situated in Baldwin County, Alabama.

3. Petitioner has no father or mother living and does not have any guardian.

4. It is to the best interest of Petitioner that his disabilities of non-age be removed, in order that he can join with the other tenants in common, or joint owners of the property in which he is interested, in conveying the same property.
