3. The said minor, Donald N. Bryant, shall file a certified copy of this decree in the office of the Judge of Probate of each county in which he shall hereafter reside, and in the office of the Judge of Probate of each county where he shall do any business or make any contracts.

4. The costs of this proceeding are hereby taxed against Petitioner, for which execution may issue.

of age.

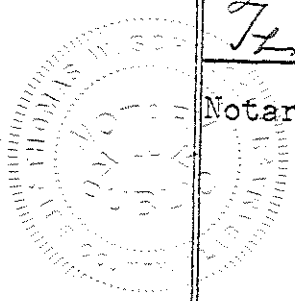
Petitioner further prays that such other orders be made

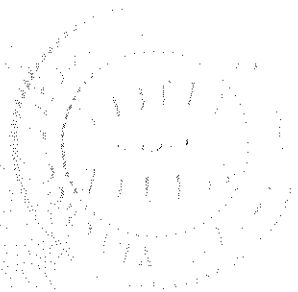
