THE HONORABLE H. M. HALL, JUDGE THEREOF:

Comes your Complainant, Artensie Cox, as Administratrix of the Estate of Jesse L. Cox, Deceased, by her solicitors, and respectfully represents and shows unto this Honorable Court and unto your Honor as follows:

FIRST:

That she is the Administratrix of the Estate of Jesse L. Cox, Deceased, having been appointed as such by the Probate Court of Baldwin County, Alabama, and that her Letters of Administration are now in full force and effect.

SECOND:

That as such Administratrix she recovered a judgment against Willie C. Davison in the Fall term of the Circuit Court of Baldwin County, Alabama, At Law, in the amount of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) and that more than thirty days have elapsed since the rendition of said judgment and the same has not been satisfied.

THIRD:

That said judgment was recovered against the said Willie C. Davison for damages on account of the wrongful death of the said Jesse L. Cox, Deceased, arising out of the operation by the Defendant of a motor vehicle and the said Willie C. Davison was insured by a contract of insurance with the Respondent herein.

FOURTH:

That the Respondent is a Corporation organized and doing business under the laws of the State of Alabama with its principal place of business in Montgomery, Alabama.

PRAYER FOR PROCESS:

The premises considered your Complainant respectfully prays that your Honor will cause the usual writ of process to be issued out of this Honorable Court and served upon the said Respondent and requiring it to plead, answer or demur to this Bill of Complaint within the time allowed by law or the rules of this Honorable Court.

PRAYER FOR RELIEF:

Your Complainant further prays that upon a final hearing of this cause that your Honor will enter an order or decree declaring that she, as the judgment creditor of the said Willie C. Davison, is entitled to have the insurance money provided for in the contract of insurance between the Respondent herein and the said Willie C. Davison applied to the satisfaction of the judgment hereinafter referred to. And your Complainant prays for such further, other and different orders or decrees as in equity will be meet and proper and which are necessary to a complete enforcement of the rights of your Complainant in the premises.
