I know that Lavern and Donald are both resident citizen of the State of Alabama and have been for more than two years next preceding this time. Lavern Drew is a resident Citizen of Baldwin County, Alabama, and have been for more than two years next preceding this time. I know that the Respondent and Complainant were married at Bay Minette, Alabama, on March 6, 1953. That Eddie Farron Drew was born to this union. That on or about November 12, 1953, Donald came to my house in a drunken condition. At that time he was very violent and threatened to kill both Lavern and her child. From his manner of conduct of speech I believe that had he not been resisted he would have carried out his threats and in my opinion Lavern cannot continue to live with Donald without jeopardizing her life.
