SECOND: That the said Murel Ruth Fowler is of temperate and industrious habits and physically developed and fully matured mentally and has the ability, character, integrity and experience to handle and manage her own affairs and property as fully and completely as if she were twenty-one years of age; that she owns property in her own right and that it is to the interest of the said Murel Ruth Fowler and of her estate that her disabilities of non-age be removed and that she be permitted, authorized and empowered to contract and be contracted with, to acquire, to own, and to convey and otherwise deal with and in real and personal property of all kinds and generally to have and exercise all control over her person and estate as if she were twenty-one years of age.

WHEREFORE your petitioners pray that due and proper notice of this petition be given as required by law, and that upon due and proper proof of the matters herein alleged this Honorable Court will make and enter a decree removing the disabilities of non-age of the said Murel Ruth Fowler and that she be permitted, authorized and empowered to contract and be contracted with, to acquire, to own and to convey and otherwise deal with and in real and personal property of all kinds and generally to have and

exercise all control over her person and estate as if she were twenty-one years of age.
