This cause came on to be heard on the 24th day of May 1954, upon the regular call of the docket, the petition filed by the petitioner pursuant to the uniform reciprocal duty of support statutes of the State of Alabama, and of the State of Tennessee, the answer of the defendant, and the testimony of the defendant heard in open Court, and the entire record in the cause, It appears from the testimony of the defendant that he is not financially able to pay more than \$15.00 per week toward the support of the dependent named in the petition, and that said amount appears to be the maximum contribution that can reasonably be required of the defendant under all the circumstances, and the defendant being entirely agreeable and willing to contribute said amount to the support of his dependent.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ACCORDINGLY ADJUDGED AND DECREED BY THE COURT, that the defendant pay into the Registry of this Court the sum of \$30.00, on the first and fifteenth day of each month hereafter, plus the Clerk's commission, for the support of his dependent. The Clerk of this Court, after deducting the commission allowed by law from the gross payments made by the defendant, will remit the net amount of \$30.00, on each first and fifteenth of each month, whenever the payments are made by the defendant, to the Clerk of the Circuit Court of Baldwin County, Bay Minette, Alabama, for the use and benefit of the dependent of the defendant named in the petition.

A copy of this order will be forwarded to the Clerk of the Circuit Court of Baldwin County, Alabama.

This order was made on May 24, 1954, and ~~was~~ entered nunc. pro tunc. The costs are taxed to the defendant.
