### STATE OF ALAEAMA

#### BALDWIN COUNTY

This agreement made and entered into on this the 1st day of March, 1954, by and between Vivian Juanita Sutton, hereinafter referred to as the Party of the First Part and Clement Francis Sutton, hereinafter referred to as the Party of the Second Part, WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Parties heretofore have been husband and wife for a period of six years, and as a result of such union have two children, Clement Ronald Sutton age 5 and Mary Isavell Sutton, age 2; and

WHEREAS said parties have definitely concluded that under conditions now existing it is inpractical for them to live together as man and wife. NOW, THEREPORE, in consideration thereof, and of mutual agreements hereinafter made they have mutually agreed to a complete separation under the following expressed terms and conditions:

1. The said parties shall entirely and completely separate as husband and wife, live separate and apart, as they have been for the past several years, and neither party hereinafter shall in any way harass, threaten, intimidate or otherwise act in anyway so as to embarass or humiliate the other party.

2. The Party of the First Party shall have the control, custody and support of their two children. The Party of the Second Part shall have the right at reasonable and convenient times to visit the said children and to have the said children to visit him for reasonable periods of time.

3. The Party of the Second Part further agrees to pay the Party of the First Part EIGHTY (\$80.00) DOLLARS per month for the care, support and maintenance of the said children. In addition thereto the Party of the Second Part agrees to pay medical expenses and the premiums on a certain educational policy which is now in effect for the benefit of Clement Ronald Sutton with the Southern Live and Health Insurance Company.

This agreement has been made and executed by the parties hereto on the day and date hereinabove first set forth, in good faith and with full understanding of all of its provisions, and with the mutual promise on the part of each to comply therewith faithfully and completely,
