COUNT TWO

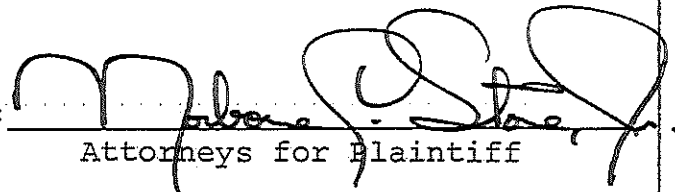

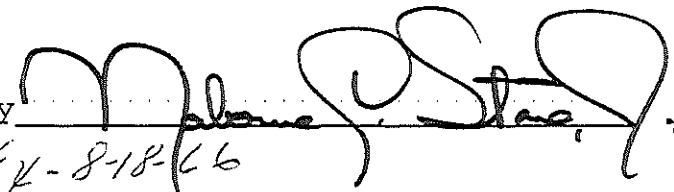

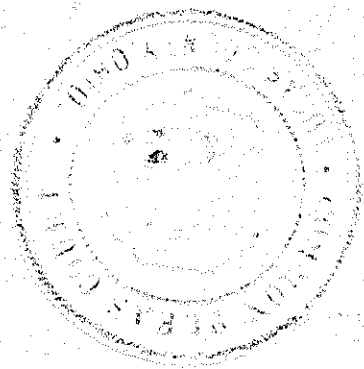
