While Warren was in the armed forces his wife Jessie lived in my home. She frequently went out at night with men who were strangers to me and came home late at night in a drunken condition. I remonstrated with her but it did not do any good. I saw her drunk frequently during the time Warren was away in the army. Some mornings she would come in as late as three or four o'clock in the morning and would hardly be able to get up the steps she would be so drunk. She was not a drunkard at the time she and Warren were married.
