This cause coming on to be heard, was submitted upon the original bill of complaint, decree pro confesso, pleadings and testimony as noted by the Register, and the court, after due consideration of the matter, is of the opinion that the complainant is entitled to the relief prayed for.

It is therefore ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the said Ernestine Mitchell and E. C. Mitchell be and the same are hereby dissolved and the complainant is forever divorced from the respondent on the grounds of cruelty.

It is further ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the said Ernestine Mitchell and E. C. Mitchell be and they are hereby granted the right to remarry upon the payment of costs in this cause.

It is further ORDERED that the said Ernestine Mitchell shall not again marry for sixty days, except to the said E. C. Mitchell, and, if an appeal is taken within sixty days, shall not marry during the pendency of said appeal, except to the said E. C. Mitchell.

It is further ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the said E. C. Mitchell pay to the said Ernestine Mitchell the sum of Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) per month beginning immediately, as permanent alimony.

It is further ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the said E. C. Mitchell pay to the said Ernestine Mitchell the sum of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) as a reasonable attorney's fee by her expended in this cause.

It is further ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the said E. C. Mitchell pay the costs herein taxed, for which execution may issue.
