FOR COMPLAINANT.

The said witnesses being first duly sworn, upon examination
of the Solicitor for the Complainant, testified in substance as fol-
lows:

INEZ McCLOUD.

I am the Complainant in this cause. Both my husband and I are over
the age of twenty-one years and were married ~~in~~ on February 17th
1923 in Mobile and lived together there as husband and wife until the
year 1929 when because of his behavior I had to leave him and came
to Fairhope where I have lived since. He has lived in different cities
since then and is now in New Orleans. From the time ~~he~~ parted he has
done nothing for my support and beyond seeing him for a moment when
he was in Fairhope two years ago, have had no relations with him at
all. ^{since about a month in Pensacola in 1936} We have lived separate and apart for now more than fourteen years
with a brief interval in 1936 when I met him in Pensacola but have
