Not guilty.

#### TWO

At the time and place alleged in the complaint, to-wit; December 12, 1965 the plaintiff's agent, servant or employee, while acting within the line of such agency, service or employment did so negligently operate an automobile in an eastwardly direction on U. S. Highway 90, a public highway in Baldwin County, Alabama, at a point approximately one mile east of Robertsdale, Alabama so as to cause or allow same to collide with an automobile in which the defendants were riding on said U. S. Highway 90 and as a direct and proximate



result thereof plaintiff's negligence proximately contributed to the accident and his alleged injuries and damages; therefore plaintiff ought not recover.
