
NOTICE FOR DISCOVERY OF ASSETS

PETITION FOR CONTEMPT PROCEEDING IN ACCORDANCE WITH AND ALLEGING VIOLATION OF TITLE 7, SECTIONS 903-907 OF THE CODE OF ALABAMA OF 1940 - RECOMPILED 1958.

TO THE HONORABLE TELFAIR J. MASHBURN, JUDGE OF SAID COURT:

Comes your petitioner, C. G. CHASON, as Attorney of Record for the Plaintiff, who is over the age of twenty-one years and respectfully shows unto this Honorable Court as follows:

1. That heretofore a final judgment was rendered by this Honorable Court in favor of the Plaintiff and against the Defendant, and that after said final judgment, execution was returned with the endorsement upon said execution of "No Property Found".

2. That in accordance with Title 7, Section 903 of the Code of Alabama 1940, Recompiled 1958, the Plaintiff filed a written request with the Circuit Clerk requesting that she issue a notice to the Defendant requiring said Defendant to file in the Circuit Court of Baldwin County, within thirty (30) days from the service of such notice, a statement in writing, under oath, of all the assets of said Defendant, including money, choses in action, notes, bonds, and accounts, and all other property, real, personal, or mixed, or any interest therein, with a detailed description of the same, the location, and reasonable value of each item thereof, together with a detailed list or statement of any and all liens, mortgages, or encumbrances thereon showing the amounts due upon each, and the owner or holder of such liens, encumbrances or mortgages.

3. That Alice J. Duck, Clerk of the Circuit Court of Baldwin County, did in accordance with Title 7, Section 903 of the Code of Alabama of 1940, Recompiled 1958, issue the notice

as set out in Paragraph 2 above to the Defendant, and the Defendant in violation of said notice has wholly failed to file statement in writing required of him; that Title 7, Section 905 of the Code of Alabama of 1940, Recompiled 1958, provides that the willful refusal to file such statement as provided for in Title 7, Section 903 shall constitute contempt of court and the person so adjudged by the court to be guilty of such contempt may be punished within the discretion of the Court as now provided by law in cases of contempt of court.



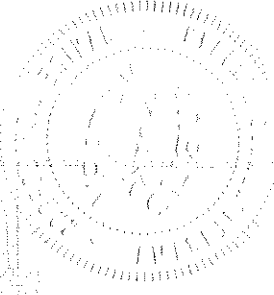
