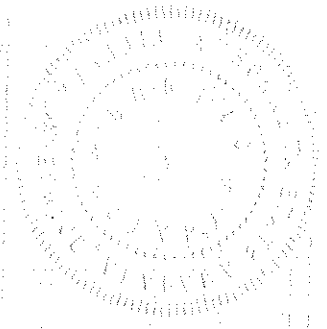


I would appreciate your adding the date on the third line of the affidavit, as I seem to have misplaced the actual date that this judgment was taken.
