IN THE MATTER OF COMPENSATION FOR DEATH:

The undersigned, being the only party interested in the above entitled matter, hereby petitions the Court for approval of the following agreement and settlement and agrees and shows unto this Honorable Court as follows:

 That the said Lois P. Archer is the widow and only survivor of O. E. Archer, and is over the age of twenty-one years, is of sound mind and a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama; that the Defendants, Joe Funk and Howard Davis, individually and d/b/a M & S Service Station, are both over twenty-one years of age, and are residents of Baldwin County, Alabama.

2. The undersigned further shows to the Court that on March 9, 1966, the decedent, O. E. Archer, a white male, age 54 years, who resided at Fairhope, Alabama, did sustain an injury while employed by the said employers, which said injury occurred at the M & S. Service Station at Fairhope, Alabama, and which injury consisted of a sprained right knee, which said injury alleged ly caused a pulmonary embolus, which resulted in death on March 21, 1966.

3. That at the time said injury was sustained, the said decedent, O. E. Archer, and the said Defendants, Joe Funk and Howard Davis, individually and d/b/a M & S Service Station, were

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subject to the provisions of the workmen's compensation laws of the State of Alabama; that said deceased employee was receiving at the time of the said injury, weekly wages of \$65.00 and that at the time of his death the only dependent of the said O.
