YOU ARE THEREFORE HEREBY COMMANDED TO SUMMON Dean Black to be and appear before the Honorable the Circuit Court for Baldwin County, at the Court House thereof, in the City of Bay Minette, within 30 days from this date, then and there to answer on oath,

whether at the time of the service of the garnishment, or at the time making his answer, or at any time intervening the time of serving the garnishment and making the answer he was indebted to said Defendant, Hubert Latner, and whether he will not be indebted in future to said Defendant, Hubert Latner, by a contract then existing, and whether by a contract then existing he is liable to said Defendant for the delivery of personal property or for the payment of money which may be discharged by the delivery of personal property, or which is payable in personal property, and whether he has not in his possession or under his control money or effects belonging to the Defendant, Hubert Latner.

Herein fail not, and have you then and there this Writ.
