The Plaintiff claims of the Defendant the sum of FOUR HUNDRED FIFTY-SIX AND 54/100 (\$456.54), due from him for merchandise, goods and chattels sold by the Plaintiff to the Defendant on the 5th day of December, 1966, which sum of money, with the interest thereon, is still unpaid.
