It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that neither party to this suit shall again marry except to each other until sixty days after the rendition of this decree, and that if appeal is taken within sixty days, neither party shall again marry except to each other during the pendency of said appeal.

It is further ordered that Dan Jackson and Willie D. Jackson be, and ~~they are~~ hereby permitted to again contract marriage upon the payment of the cost of this suit.

It is further ordered that Dan Jackson the Complainant pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which execution may issue.

That your Complainant and the Respondent are both over the age of twenty one years, and bona fide residents of Baldwin County, Alabama.

2.

That they were married at Bay Minette, Baldwin County, Alabama, on October 3rd, 1938, and lived together as husband and wife in Baldwin County, Alabama, until May 5th, 1941.

3.

That on May 5th, 1941, the Respondent voluntarily abandoned the bed and board of the Complainant, and has remained away voluntarily and continuously since that time.

My name is Dan Jackson, I am a bona fide resident of Baldwin County, Alabama, and over twenty one years of age.

The Respondent, Willie D. Jackson is over twenty one years of age and a bona fide resident of Baldwin County, Alabama, The Respondent and I were married at Bay Minette on October 3, 1938. We lived together as husband and wife until in May 5th, 1941, when the respondent voluntarily abandoned my bed and board, and has remained away voluntarily and continuously since that time.

I at no time gave the Respondent any excuse or reason for leaving me, and since May 5th, 1941, I have heard nothing from her. I know that she never intends to live with me again as my wife.

Dan Jackson

Woodie Jackson, a witness for the Complainant, being first duly sworn, deposes and says:

My name is Woodie Jackson. I live at Bay Minette, in Baldwin County Alabama. I am a brother of Dan Jackson, the Complainant. I remember when my brother and the Respondent married at Bay Minette, on October 3, 1938. Dan and the Respondent lived together as husband and wife until on May 5th, 1941, when the Respondent voluntarily abandoned him. She has remained away voluntarily and continuously since that time, and they have not at any time lived together as husband and wife.

I have been with my brother practically all the time since the Respondent left him. I know that the Complainant provided for the Respondent as best he could, and cared for her to the best of his ability. She had no reason for leaving him other than that he got into a little trouble and immediately she left him, and continued to stay away.


