



COUNT ONE:

The Plaintiff claims of the Defendant the sum of Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00) due under a contract of insurance entered into in writing between the parties in Baldwin County, Alabama, on the 9th Day of February, 1963, for benefits provided by the policy wherein the Defendant agreed to pay to the Plaintiff the sum of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) per month for loss of time for the term of three (3) months from the date of sickness causing

continuous total disability and total loss of time and requiring regular and personal attendance by a licensed physician but not requiring continuous confinement within doors. Such sickness commencing more than thirty (30) days after the policy date. And the Plaintiff alleges that during the month of October, 1965, while the policy was in force under its terms that the Plaintiff suffered continuous total and permanent disability from arthritis causing total loss of time and requiring regular and personal attendance by a licensed physician and that the Defendant has failed to pay the amount due the Plaintiff under said policy to the date hereof, hence this suit.
