
I know of my own personal knowledge that during the time that she was living, or trying to live with Leonard Rigsby that he often threatened and abused her and on several occasions did actual violence to her person which necessarily endangered her life and health. I prevailed upon her to do everything possible to make her married life a success but when the respondent on October 20, 1943, choked her and threatened to kill her with a gun I advised her to no longer subject herself to the bad treatment of the Respondent as he might and probably would carry out his threats and kill her.

Complainant further prays that upon a final hearing hereof, your Honor will give and grant unto her an absolute decree of divorce, forever barring the bonds of matrimony existing between her and the Respondent, and that your Honor will give and grant unto her such other, further, different and general relief as she may be in equity and good conscienceentitled to receive, and as in duty bound she will ever pray.

He expressly denies that he at any time was cruel to the Complainant, or that he committed actual violence to her person, and demands strict proof thereof.


