It is further understood and agreed that default in the making of any payment when due as provided in said note shall entitle the Bank to immediate possession of the property described herein for the purpose as herein provided. At any time said Bank shall deem itself insecure it may take possession of said property, and retain the same in some convenient place, at the risk and expense of the undersigned, until the debts, obligations or liabilities hereby secured are fully paid, including any expenses incurred for seizure and storage of the personal property, or the said property is sold in the manner hereinafter specified. 




